The Mill Creek Fire Company is a volunteer emergency service provider made up of citizens from your community. We volunteer our time and skills to assist the residents and visitors of our response district during fire, rescue and medical emergencies. We respond to your emergency, 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year. In **2015** we responded to **847** fire/rescue related emergencies and **5,200** medical emergencies.

Fortunately for our organization, there are hundreds of people, like you, in our community who realize the expense involved in emergency services. Maintaining state-of-the-art firefighting vehicles, ambulances, rescue equipment, two fire stations (Marshallton and Pike Creek Valley) and delivering programs that teach children fire prevention can be very costly.

Mill Creek Fire Company is now conducting its annual fund drive and we are asking for your continued support. A donation of **\$35.00 per household** will help us meet expenses that are budgeted to exceed \$2 million for this year.

Our annual fund drive request is by letter only. We do not solicit any donations by telephone so please be cautious about telephone calls soliciting funds for your local fire company. In addition we do not employ a telemarketer to handle our fund drive. All efforts are handled by our volunteers except for the printing of our letter and the bulk mailing process.

As a reminder, we recommend that you change the batteries in your smoke detectors twice a year. Remember, change your clock and change your batteries. If you should need a smoke detector or batteries please stop by one of our fire stations at 3808 Kirkwood Highway or 4021 Skyline Drive. They are available free of charge.
